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1 **I. Call to Order**

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3 Mayor Crawley called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m.

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5 **II. Acknowledgment of Quorum by Chairman**

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13 **IV. Consider approval of the minutes of the MPO Policy Board meeting of February 4, 2026**

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16 Mayor Crawley inquired if all members had reviewed the minutes from the previous Policy Board meeting on February 4, 2026.

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19 Motion to approve the minutes of the MPO Policy Board meeting of February 4, 2026 was made by Mayor Teamann, seconded by Mayor McDonald. Motion Carries.

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22 **V. Review the 2027-2030 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) and Approve a Resolution Adopting the 2027-2030 TIP**

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25 Mr. Barnett explained this is the 2027-2030 TIP and that every two years the MPO is required to pass a Transportation Improvement Program that covers a 4-year period. He stated that the TIP was released for public comment on March 9th, and a public hearing was held on March 18th in conjunction with the TAC meeting. He stated that no comments were received. He added that the most notable item about this TIP is that it does not include any construction projects during this 4-year period. He stated that this can be amended should funding be received.

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32 Motion to approve the Resolution Adopting the TIP, was made by Mayor McDonald, seconded by Mayor Teamann. Motion Carries.

Authorize Execution of a Grant Agreement Under the Fiscal Year 2025 Safe Streets and Roads for All Grant Program Between the United States Department of Transportation's (USDOT) Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and the Grayson County MPO**

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40 Mr. Barnett explained that the MPO applied for a Safe Streets for All (SS4A) grant and it has recently been approved. The Federal Highway Administration and Mr. Barnett have worked on a draft for this grant which is up for review.

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3 Mr. Barnett announced that the next Policy Board meeting is scheduled for June 3, 2026. He added

Discussion and Authorization to Release for Public Comment Proposed Amendments to the 2050 Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP)

BACKGROUND:

This is the third amendment to the 2050 MTP.

Revisions in the amendment include:

- 1) Adjusting the letting year and funding for Project GC2036-01, and
- 2) Breaking GC2039-01 into two segments, adjusting the letting year and funding.

Schedule moving forward would be to release the proposed amendments for public comment on July 2, 2026. A public hearing will be held in conjunction with the Technical Advisory Committee meeting scheduled for July 22, 2026. The proposed amendments could be considered for adoption at the September 2, 2026 Policy Board Meeting.
